The NZ Army is looking for good operators to be in the new Female Engagement Team (FET) as part of 1 NZSAS Regt.

WHAT IS FET?

The Female Engagement Team (FET) is a military derived organisation comprised of female soldiers who are trained to support SOF operations. Their primary role is to engage with local female and adolescent population present at SOF objectives, in scenarios where such engagement would be culturally unacceptable for a male SOF soldier to perform. FET personnel receive training in soldier survivability, operational orientation, general and regional culture, engagement, face-to-face communication, civil reconnaissance and tactical information collection.

Operational experience has demonstrated the power of employing females to engage with all aspects of societies, especially women and children; recent examples include Bougainville, East Timor and Afghanistan.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES:

Will be trained as support enablers for SOF and wider NZDF operations.

Will upskill in soldier survivability, language, regional culture, communicating and infil techniques.
